

HISTORY OF BIRTH

Identifying data. Surname. Name. Patronymic name. Age and date of birth. Married status. Nationality. Education. Occupation. Place of work. Home address. Date of hospitalization. Diagnosis. Condition of the patient on admission to the hospital.

Anamnesis vitae. Date of birth, starting to walk, somatic diseases and diseases of reproductive tract, operations, heredity diseases, blood transfusions, allergy reactions, smoking, using of alcohol and drugs, hobbies.

Anamnesis function. Menstrual functions (menarche, duration of cycle, complains, using medicines for pain relief, changes of menstrual cycle after starting of sexual activities). Date of last menses.

Sexual activities and outcomes of previous pregnancies.

Function of surrounding organs.

Course of present pregnancy (preconceptional preparing, complications, first moving of the fetus, observations in female dispensary).

Common condition and objective investigations.

General condition. State of consciousness. Height, weight, body temperature. Color of skin. Edema. Mammas.

Respiratory system (breaths rate, palpation, auscultation).

Cardiovascular system (pulse, blood pressure, auscultation).

Digestive system (appetite, smell from the mouth, palpation of liver, sounds of peristaltic).

Urinary system (urination, incontinence).

Measurements of pelvis. External and internal examination of reproductive organs.

Laboratory and ultrasound investigation.

Diagnosis on admission to the hospital.

Clinical course of labor.

The first stage of labor (beginning of contractions, common condition, fetal condition, condition of reproductive organs, using of spasmolytics or analgesics, rupture of amniotic sac)

The second stage of labor (beginning of pushing, common condition, fetal condition, condition of reproductive organs, indication for episiotomy). Time of delivery, weight, height and Apgar score of newborn).

The third stage of labor (signs of placenta's separation, blood loss, size and weight of afterbirth).

Examination of birth canal (ruptures, hematomas). General condition after delivery.
