1. Psoriasis. Lichen Planus. Pityriasis rosea. **Curation of patients.**
2. Bullous diseases: Pemphigus. Pemphigoid. Dermatitis Herpetiformis.

3. Introduction to venereology. Methods of examination of patient with sexually transmitted diseases. General pathology of syphilis. Primary and secondary syphilis.
4. Tertiary syphilis. Inborn (congenital) syphilis. Malignant, transfusion and latent syphilis. Serological diagnosis, treatment and prevention of syphilis. Protection case history.

5. Gonococcal infection. Gonorrhea in men.

6. Venereal (nongonococcal) urethritis in men: trichomoniasis, chlamidiosis, urea- and mycoplasmosis, candidiasis, etc. Acquired immunodeficiency syndrome (AIDS). Lesions on the skin and mucous membranes at HIV infection. **Examination test.**
