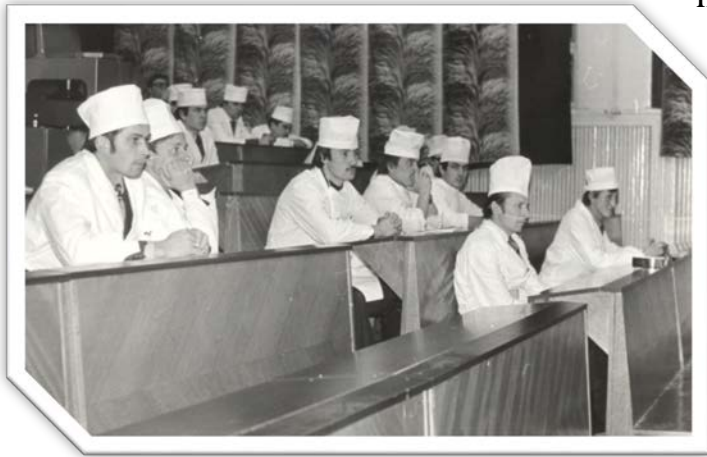


The Student Research Society (SRS) of the 1st Department of Surgical Diseases

has existed since the department was founded. Up to 20 students of 4, 5 and 6 courses of the medical faculty and the Faculty of Foreign Students are engaged in regular scientific research and practical work in the department.



Society meetings are held monthly where students submit reports on their research papers and discuss scientific problems related to it. During the academic year, usually 8-9 meetings are held.





Such forms of students' scientific work are most developed: the search and analysis of the necessary literature on the topic; participation in medical work, dressing changing, examination of patients, scrubbing in the operations; working with clinical documentation and files in the archive; preparation and execution of vocal and poster presentations; preparation and writing reports, articles and scientific papers; publication of research results in popular scientific journals; preparation of computer presentations and videos.

Students who take an active part in the work of a scientific society are involved in practical work and scientific research in related departments and research divisions- Central Scientific Research Laboratory, Institute of Biochemistry, Pathological Anatomy and Laboratories. SRS of the department is constantly expanding, the number of students is increasing, which in turn increases the number of student works, including those awarded with various diplomas and prizes.





This is connected with the students' understanding of the importance of the scientific and practical growth of the future doctor, the available opportunities to publish and have printed scientific works by the time of graduation from the university. The experience gained by students in the process of

working a society helps them in the future work as medical practitioners and contributes to their active professional and scientific growth.
