5. Aseptics, antiseptics, general rules.
6. Definition of the concept of "healthcare-associated infections" (HAIs). Risk factors for the development of HAIs, classification.
7. Source of infection, ways and factors of the transmission, the definition of the HAIs disease.
8. Rules of hygienic hand antiseptic.

29. Crush-syndrome (traumatic rhabdomyolysis or Bywaters' syndrome): clinical manifestations, the basics of the emergency medical care.
30. The types of Eye Injuries (foreign bodies, injuries to the eyeball and eyelids, chemical exposures and burns): clinical manifestations, the basics of the emergency care.
31. Dislocations and fractures: concept and clinical manifestations.
32. First aid for injuries of bones and joints, gunshot wounds of the musculoskeletal system.

49. The concept of the cardiovascular resuscitation. The main resuscitation measures (open airway, artificial ventilation, cardiac compressions). Criteria for the effectiveness of the cardiovascular resuscitation.

50. The main symptoms of the diseases of the gastrointestinal tract.

51. The concept and the main features of the "acute abdominal pain" syndrome. Rules of the transportation of patients with acute abdominal pain syndrome.

52. Gastrointestinal bleeding: causes, clinical symptoms, basics of emergency medical care at the prehospital stage.

53. The concept of the "renal colic", the main clinical symptoms, the basics of emergency medical care at the prehospital stage.

54. Clinical signs of life-threatening conditions in diseases of the central nervous system.

55. Clinical signs of loss of consciousness, the main causes. Seizures, types of seizures. Epileptic seizures. Hysterical seizures.

56. First aid for patients with diseases of the nervous system.

57. First aid for patients with hallucinations, delirium, loss of consciousness.

58. Injuries of the spinal cord and brain: the basics of emergency medical care at the prehospital stage, peculiarities of the transportation of victims and patients.

59. The concept and the mechanism of thermoregulation.

60. Clinical manifestations of fever.

61. First aid for patients with fever.

62. Warming, cold compresses, heating pads, ice packs usage; indications, contraindications.

63. Allergic reactions, the main symptoms and types.

64. Urticaria, drug allergy, anaphylaxis, angioedema (Quincke's edema), first aid.

65. The concept of "acute poisoning".

66. Classification of poisoning and toxic substances. Periods of the acute poisoning.

67. Clinical manifestations of the most frequent acute poisoning (carbon monoxide, alcohol, drugs, poisonous (toxic) plants, mushrooms, pesticides used in agriculture, household poisons).

68. Basics of emergency medical care for acute poisoning at the prehospital stage. Gastric lavage technique.

69. Bites of poisonous snakes, insects, animals: clinical symptoms, the basics of emergency medical care at the prehospital stage.

70. Peculiarities of the first aid in extreme situations (traffic accident, fires).

71. Rules of work in an emergency (features of creating a safe environment and rules for providing assistance).

72. Inhalation of smoke, asphyxia, drowning, the basics of emergency medical care.
