On the ground of the aforesaid the students' knowledge assessment criteria on the subject **"PSYCHIATRY AND NARCOLOGY"** were accepted according to the following level of knowledge:

The level	Characteristics	Marks
	Ignorance (lack of knowledge or refusal to answer)	1
I	Knowledge-recognition or knowledge-acquaintance (poor knowledge)	2 – 3
II	Knowledge-replica	
A	Unconscious simple reproduction	4 – 5
B	Conscious reproduction	6 – 7
III	Knowledge-skills	8 – 9
IV	Knowledge-transformation (creative activity)	10

**Attachment to the students' knowledge assessment
The psychiatry and narcology examination testing estimation**
(subject to 60 test questions per 1 being tested):

- 10 (ten) points is given for the student, that has 58 and more correct answers from 60 possible;
- 9 (nine) points – no less, than 54 answers;
- 8 (eight) points – no less, than 48 answers;
- 7 (seven) points – no less, than 42 answers;
- 6 (six) points – no less, than 36 answers;
- 5 (five) points – no less, than 30 answers;
- 4 (four) points – no less, than 24 answers;
- the student that has less than 24 correct answers gets unsatisfactory mark.
