

List of competences and skills in the discipline "Psychology and pedagogy".

Psychology and pedagogy is presented in two Parts: "Fundamentals of Psychology" and "Fundamentals of Pedagogy".

The student should know:

- concepts and categories, cultural significance and place of psychology and pedagogy in human and social sciences;
- modern concepts of education and personal development, teaching methods and techniques of self-improvement;
- individual psychological qualities and personality traits;
- social and psychological mechanisms and patterns of individual and group behavior;
- educational trends, functions and models of education;
- the structure and direction of national education system development;
- principles and approaches to the use of psychological and pedagogical knowledge to deal with personal, social and professional problems;
- fundamentals of family pedagogy.

The student should be able to:

- organize productive interpersonal and professional interaction and communication, including a multicultural environment;
- identify personal characteristics with the age and gender differences and use them in the process of communication in social and professional spheres;
- provide adequate self-esteem, develop and implement projects of self-education, and self-improvement.
