## ASSESSMENT ALGORITHM AND BONUS (EXTRA) GRADE POINTS FOR ACADEMIC SUBJECT "RUSSIAN AS A FOREIGN LANGUAGE"

Criteria for obtaining the "passed" mark and admission to a graded test:

- making up missed classes and getting a positive mark (not lower than 4 grade points),
- writing a test paper with a positive mark (not lower than 4 grade points),
- passing the oral topics provided by the syllabus with a positive mark (not lower than 4 grade points).

Criteria for assessing **the vocabulary and grammar test** on the educational portal in Moodle system:

**The final mark** at the graded test is an integral indicator and is calculated based on the student's grade point average and marks given to the student at the graded test, where the weight coefficient of the students' grade point average is 0.4.

A prerequisite for passing the graded test is:

- passing the text-based assignment, the oral topic / discussion / spontaneous statement with a positive mark (not lower than 4 grade points);

- completing the vocabulary and grammar test with at least a 40%.

The final mark at the graded test is calculated by the formula

$$FM = GPA \times 0.4 + \frac{T_1 + T_2 + T_3}{3} \times 0.6$$

Where FM – final mark; GPA – grade point average,  $T_1$ ,  $T_2$ ,  $T_3$  – marks, received by a students for task 1, task 2 and task 3 in the examination card ( $T_1$  – text-based assignment;  $T_2$  – vocabulary and grammar test;  $T_3$  – oral topic / discussion /spontaneous statement).

If a student has bonus (extra) grade points, he can be freed from performing all the tasks of the examination card (when passing a graded test) in the following order: text-based assignment (T1), vocabulary and grammar test (T2), oral topic / discussion / spontaneous statement (T3).

Bonus (extra) grade points from 3 to 5 can be added to the numerator of the fraction (see the formula) or added up and counted for one of the examination card tasks.

The student may refuse to issue a bonus (extra) grade point for the examination card task and perform the corresponding task of the examination card with the right to choose one of the two marks.
